About Resonance

In Physics, 'Resonance' is the tendency of a system to oscillate with larger amplitudes at some frequencies. These are known as the system's resonant frequencies. At these frequencies, even small periodic driving forces can produce large amplitude oscillations, because the system stores vibrational energy.

Mr. R. K. Verma, being a Physics Teacher himself chose to name his first edupreneurial venture as 'Resonance'. Resonance came into being on 11th April, 2001 at Kota as the preparatory institute for IIT-JEE; the toughest entrance examination for admission in coveted engineering institutes i.e. IITs. The institute was named as Resonance with the commitment to enhance the benefits of teaching up to the greatest level of satisfaction of students and to bring them in the frequency band of teacher so that the scientific phenomenon of resonance becomes a reality.

The initial focus of the institute was to provide objective-centric classroom contact coaching a systematic and conducive learning environment for challenging examinations like IIT-JEE. In the beginning; this coaching was aimed at students of Class XI, XII and XII+ but later on, backward integration helped incorporate students from Class VII to X also. The programs for these classes are primarily intended towards developing competitive quotient amongst the students at an early age.

To enhance the reach of Resonance's well-researched Study Material; Distance Learning Program was also started in 2003 to cater to the need of students staying in all parts of the country.

In a major lateral diversification strategy; Academic Session 2011-12 witnessed launching of Classroom Contact Programs for other popular entrance examinations AIEEE and AIPMT as well.

Going with the winds of change and understanding the importance of technology in education; Resonance also launched its e-Learning Program Division (e-LPD) in 2010. The e-learning initiative shall further enhance the reach of Resonance's educational products & services from national to global students fraternity.

Delivering outstanding results consistently has become a major distinguishing factor for Resonance. Resonance has consistently lived up to its promise of facilitating students in realizing a bright future. 

STaRT stands for:

Scholarship & Talent Reward Test

STaRT is an aptitude cum bench-marking test to be conducted by Resonance to reach out, spot, reward & nurture talented students across the country and support them in fulfilling their career aspirations.

For a sincere & aspiring student, STaRT would provide a platform to showcase his/her talent to the nation which will boost his/her confidence to perform well in competitive examinations ahead & make a bright career.

Who can participate in STaRT-2013 ?

The STaRT-2013 would be conducted for the students of Class-V to Class-XII of Private, Government and Government aided schools (All Boards) of any medium in Indian Territory.

- Class V, VI, VII, VIII, IX & X.
- Class-XI (Science Stream): For Mathematics & Biology both Stream
- Class-XII (Science Stream): For Mathematics & Biology both Stream
- Class-XI+XII (Open Stream): For all streams including Science, Arts, Commerce, Agriculture, Fine Arts, Home Science, Vocational etc.

Test Paper Structure: Stage-I

STaRT-2013 will be conducted in English & Hindi Medium Both. Student should fill his choice of medium in the Registration Form correctly. Test Paper of Stage-I will be of 90 Minutes. Paper will be off maximum 200 Marks having 50 objective type questions. There will be 1/4 negative marking i.e. 4 marks will be awarded for every correct answer & 1 mark will be deducted for every wrong answer. No marks shall be awarded / deducted for unattempted question. Break up of 50 questions will be as follows:

- A. For Class-V to X:** Subject-wise Break up of Questions
15 questions from Mathematics, 10 questions from Mental Ability, 15 from Science (5 questions each from Physics, Chemistry & Biology) and 10 from Social Science (3 questions each from Economics & Civics and 2 questions each from History & Geography).
- B. Class-XI & XII (Science Stream: Mathematics/Biology):** Subject-wise Break up of Questions
15 questions each from Physics, 10 from Chemistry, 10 from Mental Ability, & 15 from Mathematics / Biology (As per students respective streams).
- C. Class-XI & XII (Open Stream: Non-Science):** Subject-wise Break up of Questions
20 questions from Quantitative Aptitude, 20 from General Awareness, 10 from English.

Test Paper Structure: Stage-II

Stage-II Test will also be conducted in English & Hindi Medium Both. Test Paper of Stage-II will be of 120 Minutes. Paper will be off maximum 300 Marks having 75 objective type questions. There will be 1/4 negative marking i.e. 4 marks will be awarded for every correct answer & 1 mark will be deducted for every wrong answer. Break up of 75 questions will be as follows:

- A. For Class-V to X:** Subject-wise Break up of Questions
25 questions from Mathematics, 10 from Mental Ability, 25 from Science (10 from Physics, 8 from Chemistry & 7 from Biology) and 15 from Social Science (4 each from Economics, Geography & Civics and 3 questions from History).
- B. Class-XI & XII (Science Stream: Mathematics/Biology):** Subject-wise Break up of Questions: 20 questions each from Physics, 15 from Chemistry, 15 from Mental Ability, & 25 questions from Mathematics / Biology (As per students respective streams).
- C. Class-XI & XII (Open Stream: Non-Science):** Subject-wise Break up of Questions
30 questions from Quantitative Aptitude, 25 from General Awareness, 20 from English.

STaRT-2013 Conditions for Prizes in Stage-II

- Prizes Title:** The prizes titles may be changed within the monetary worth of the prize.
- Tie Breaker:** In case of more than one participating student secure equal aggregate marks in stage-II then the higher Rank shall be given by comparing scores individually in the subjects in decreasing priority order of:
 - Mathematics, Mental Ability, General Science (P, C, B), General Awareness for Class V to X.
 - Mathematics/Biology, Physics, Chemistry & Mental Ability for Class XI & XII (Science Stream).
 - For Open Category: Quantitative Aptitude, General Awareness & General English.

If individual scores in all the subjects are also equal then the aggregate score of Stage-I shall be compared, which if also found equal then individual scores in subjects shall be compared in the same priority order as above and if they are also equal then the student youngest in age shall be given higher rank.
- NASA-USA, CERN-ESA-Europe & SCIENCE CENTRE-SINGAPORE Visits:** The tours are subject to various approvals from the respective touring locations. The visits shall be arranged within 6 months from declaration of final result based on tour availability with an external agency. The students shall have to get ready their passports beforehand and submit its photocopy to Resonance latest by 31st March 2013.
- Non-Transferability of prizes:** All the prizes are non-transferable in terms

- of person or prize title. However, a student may opt for Tour of Lower worth within the three tours offered above if he/she has won a prize of higher worth. (E.g. a NASA-USA Tour winner may opt for CERN-ESA-EUROPE Tour but vice-versa is NOT allowed.). Difference of amount shall not be payable in such case.
- The itinerary of tours is available on STaRT-2013 website at www.resostart.in. The tour itinerary may also be changed within the duration of the tour. It will be updated on website, if any change happens.
- In extreme condition; if we are unable to conduct the tours (First Three Prize Categories); the students may be paid 90% amount of Tour Prize Money in cash. The 10% deductions shall be done against the correspondence, communication & coordination charges done with students and tour operator.
- The prizes of first 25 Prize categories (based on All India Rank-AIR) shall be awarded to the students only when they attend the Felicitation Function & Champions' Camp (wherever applicable) at Kota (Rajasthan). A student failing to any of the two (as applicable) shall not be allowed to receive the prizes.
- The prizes of other Prize categories (from 26-200 & based on All India Rank-AIR) may be sent by post/courier to the students or may be personally collected by the students in the STaRT-2013 Felicitation Function & Champions' Camp (wherever applicable) or from Resonance's Study Centre (in respective City, if available).
- No Award/Prize Money shall be handed over (in person) to any of student's relative/guardian or his/her representative in any case.
- A student has to produce required documents to claim his/her Award/Prize Money (as required by Resonance).

STaRT-2013 Scholarships for Students

The successful students in Stage-II shall be entitled for scholarships in Resonance's Various Programs upon taking admission in academic session 2013-14 at any of its authorized Study Centre across India.

- ♦ The scholarship is valid for one year only i.e. for Academic Session: 2013-14 (Availed or Not availed). It shall be applicable on total fee (excluding Caution Money) without combining any other scholarship offer
- ♦ **For Yearlong Classroom Contact Program (YCCP) Science Students:** The scholarships shall be applicable to a student only after taking admission in respective program (at Kota/Authorized Study Centre of Resonance across India) in the first batch commencing in the month of April, 2013 or earlier (or as per the Academic Calendar of Resonance for the Academic Session: 2013-14). This Scholarship Offer is valid upto 15.03.2013 till office hours only and will become void w.e.f. 16.03.2013).
- ♦ **For YCCP Commerce Students:** A Commerce student can avail the Scholarship offered in STaRT-2013 only in the First Course of Commerce Division starting in Academic Session 2013-14.
- ♦ **For Yearlong Classroom Contact Program (YCCP):** The scholarship is

valid for one/first year only i.e. for Academic Session: 2013-14. If a student opts for any of our Two-Yearlong Program (Especially Class-X appearing/ passed students); the scholarship for the second year (2014-15) shall be determined only on the basis of our other available criteria mentioned in the ResoGuide (2012-13 & 2013-14).

- ♦ Student can avail only one best scholarship in case he/she is eligible for more than one scholarship under different criteria by Resonance through any other scholarship program.
- ♦ If a student opts for a particular program & Resonance doesn't offer any such program suitable for the student; this Scholarship Program shall stand void and cancelled. A student cannot claim for it in any other form.
- ♦ All other condition for admission as stipulated in ResoGuide Academic Session 2012-13/13-14 (if updated) shall be applicable.
- ♦ In case of any dispute, decision of Managing Director shall be final and abided to all the parties.
- ♦ All the legal matters related to STaRT-2013 shall be subject to Kota (Rajasthan) Jurisdiction only.

STaRT-2013 Champions' Camp

1. The Top-100 students of each class V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI (Science) and Open Category (XI & XII) shall be called up at Kota for a 3-day Champions' Camp (Total 100x8=800 Students).
2. The Top-25 students shall be reimbursed, accommodation, travel & food expenses during the camp.
3. The Top-25 students shall be reimbursed to & from train ticket (II-SL)/eq. bus ticket upto a maximum of Rs. 1200/- both ways.
4. The parents (if they accompany their ward) shall not be provided accommodation at Resonance's cost. However, they may be assisted in finding an accommodation.
5. The camp shall be held in a residential campus arranged by Resonance.
6. Students from AIR-26 to 100 can also attend the camp. They will be reimbursed only to & from train ticket (II-SL)/eq. bus ticket upto a maximum of Rs. 1200/- both ways. Resonance shall not bear their accommodation & food expenses.
